What's happening in the Prep -2 Room Term 3

Welcome back everybody! This term Miss Purcell will be teaching the students in Prep-2. We have many fun learning activities planned and have already started with updating our readers and Mioow words from last term. Thank you to the parents who have been able to attend Parent / Teacher Interviews this week. It has been wonderful to catch up with parents and touch base with each student and how they are developing. If you haven't been able to come along please call the school and arrange a time to discuss your child's learning progress. This term we are continuing our work with Mioow words and also starting to learn how to write and spell these correctly. In literacy we are working on reading strategies such as predicting, visualising, questioning and recalling key information. In writing we are working on recounts, procedural texts and reports. We are also spending some time on working on our correct pencil grip and how to form letters of the alphabet. In numeracy we are working on measurement, shapes, graphs and counting on and back from even numbers and odd numbers.

What's happening in the Grade 3-6 Room Term 3

Hello and welcome to term 3 at Tungamah Primary School! Last term saw some tremendous work done by the 3 to 6 grade with fantastic effort put in to all areas of the curriculum. Students worked hard to improve on their report and narrative writing as well as expanding their understanding of decimals and fractions. They also worked hard on the space concept of the term and created a solar system display to hang in the classroom! This term, the grade 3-6 room will be continuing on with report writing as well as learning how to write explanations. In maths we will be working on measurement and shape and from this we will plan and hopefully redesign to veggie garden next to Miss Purcell's room so we can grow and cook some delicious food later in the year! For our first term concept we will be looking into history and great leaders and what it takes to be a great leader. We have also started a Perceptual Motor Program (PMP) this term focusing on spacial awareness, hand-eye coordination and memory to help students improve in their learning.
